## Walking Tour on Wednesday, 24th April 2019

## By Train

This walking tour, led by Jennifer Toynbee-Holmes, is to complement the lecture she is giving on Tuesday, 16th April entitled "The Holland Park Circle": a group of 19th century artists (including Frederick Leighton, George Frederick Watts, William Burges Luke Fildes, Valentine Prinsep) who established their studios in and around the newly fashionable Holland Park.

Jennifer will lead us on a walking tour of the Holland Park artists' houses, studios and workshops. We will meet Jennifer at 12.30 at The Holland Park Cafe (Ilchester Place, W8 6LU). The tour will take approximately one hour and will end at LEIGHTON HOUSE Museum. If you would like to stay on and see Leighton House and garden, as well as its wonderful art collection, tickets must be bought on the day (£7.00 for senior citizens). There is a free guided tour of the house at 3.00 pm - normally tours are an additional charge.

18 Stafford Terrace, the Sambourne family house, is a ten minute walk from Leighton House and is part of the Museum. From 1875 it was the home of the Punch cartoonist, Edward Linley Sambourne, a rather colourful character, and it remained in the family and largely unchanged until ownership was passed to the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea. It comes very highly recommended by our Tour Guide. (Open 2.00 - 5.30. Entrance £5.00 for senior citizens)
